Belief in the importance of individual freedom and limited government intervention, which aligns with libertarian political philosophy.

## Moral / Ethical

Belief in the inherent value of all human life and the principle that taking another person's life is morally wrong, which forms the basis of opposition to the death penalty.

## Personal

Belief in the power of positive thinking and the idea that a positive attitude can lead to personal success and well-being.
