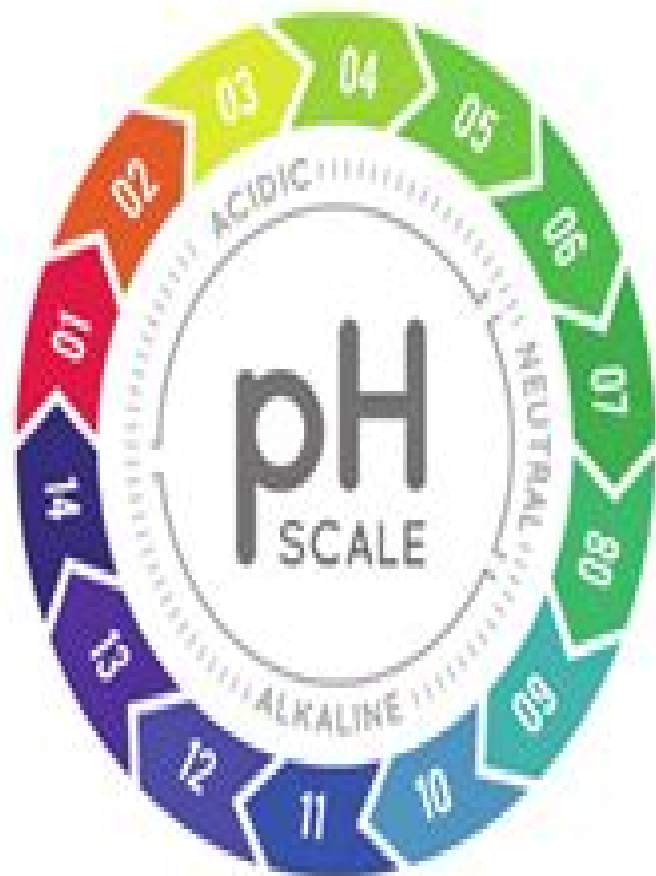


Acid-Base Balance



Acid-base balance refers to the regulation of hydrogen ion concentration in the body to maintain a stable pH within the normal range (7.35–7.45), essential for optimal cellular function.

key components :

- pH: 7.35-7.45
- PaCO_2 : 35-45 mmHg
- HCO_3^- : 22-28 mEq/L

- Respiratory System
- Renal System
