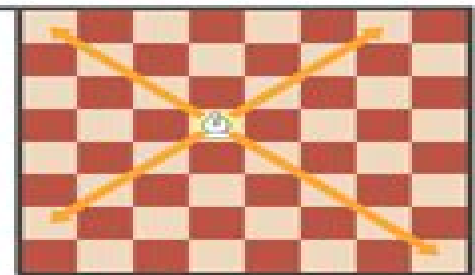

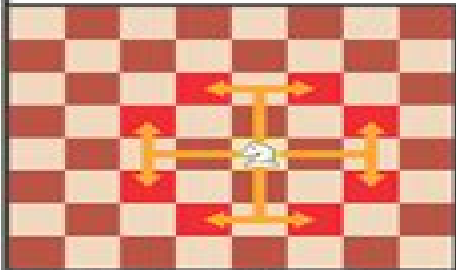
- The rook moves like a "+".

Knight

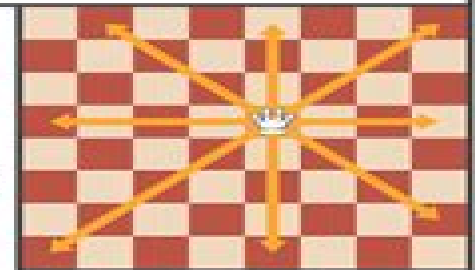

King

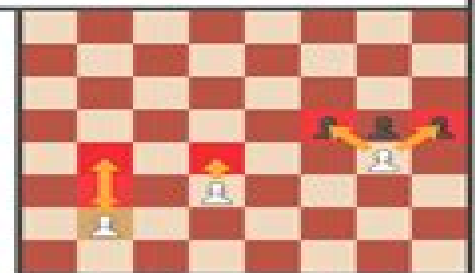
