The **hoop** construction using its legs. It rolls its legs at top together to make a hoop, and "hoops" through a fish's nostrils as its front legs



Use the **whisker** called **"tentacles"** help the fish to sense food when swimming in sea



The **spine** fish is actually an **elongated tooth**. It can sense temperature, acidity, salinity and more



The **fly** has **compound eyes** that consist of thousands of tiny eyes. It can see 360 degrees around it with 120,000 fly and moving 100% of what it sees to find its flight



Using the fish's **skin** which is its **photoreception**. It can sense light and color. It's a great defense mechanism as it can change its color to blend in with its surroundings
