## DEFINITION

Comparative psychology studies the behavior and cognitive processes of animal and humans, to understand the evolutionary and developmental underpinnings of these behaviors. By comparing and contrasting across species, this discipline seeks to identify universal patterns and unique adaptations.

## EXAMPLE

Under the tutelage of Irene Pepperberg, a grey parrot named Alex exhibited understanding of concepts such as color, shape, quantity, and even the concept of 'zero.' Pepperberg's work offered insights not only into avian cognition but also raised questions about the nature of language and cognition in general.
