Black Indian Slave Narratives Patrick Neal Mingos, 2004 Few people realize that Native Americans were enslaved right alongside the African Americans in this country Fewer still realize that many Native Americans owned African Americans and Native Americans from other tribes Recently historians have determined that of the 2 193 interviews with former slaves that were collected by the Federal Writers Project 12 percent contain some reference to the interviewees being related to or descended from Native Americans In addition many of the interviewees make references to their Native American owners In *Black Indian Slave Narratives* Patrick Mingos offers the most absorbing of these firsthand testimonies about African American and Native American relationships in the 19th century The selections include an interview with Felix Lindsey who was born in Kentucky of Mvskoke African heritage and who served as one of the buffalo soldiers who rounded up Geronimo Chaney Mack whose father was a full blood African from Liberia and whose mother was a pure blood Indian gives an in depth look at both sides of her cultural heritage including her mother s visions based on the night the stars fell over Alabama There are stories of Native Americans taken by nigger stealers who found themselves placed on slave auction blocks alongside their African counterparts The narratives in this collection provide insight into the lives of people who lived in complex and dynamically interconnected cultures The interviews also offer historical details of capture and enslavement life in the Old South and the Old West Indian removal and slavery in the Indian territory Patrick Mingos worked for 17 years for Amnesty International and Human Rights Watch He teaches in Stokes County Schools and at Forsyth Technical Community College in Winston Salem He is also the author of *Slavery in the Cherokee Nation The Keetowah Society and the Defining of a People 1855 1867* and *Far More Terrible for Women Personal Accounts of Women in Slavery* This book is an important contribution to the dialogue about relationships between African Americans and Native Americans and the complex political context in which these narratives were recorded Patrick does not over analyze this often emotional subject He simply allows the people to tell their stories Wilma Mankiller

Andrews, 2011-04-25 The pre Civil War autobiographies of famous fugitives such as Frederick Douglass William Wells Brown and Harriet Jacobs form the bedrock of the African American narrative tradition After emancipation arrived in 1865 former slaves continued to write about their experience of enslavement and their upward struggle to realize the promise of freedom and citizenship *Slave Narratives After Slavery* reprints five of the most important and revealing first person narratives of slavery and freedom published after 1865 Elizabeth Keckley's controversial *Behind the Scenes* 1868 introduced white America to the industry and progressive outlook of an emerging black middle class The little known *Narrative of the life of John Quincy Adams When in Slavery and Now as a Freeman* 1872 gave eloquent voice to the African American working class as it migrated from the South to the North in search of opportunity William Wells Brown's *My Southern Home* 1880 retooled the image of slavery delineated in his widely read antebellum *Narrative* and offered his reader a first hand assessment of the South at the close of Reconstruction Lucy Ann Delaney used *From the Darkness Cometh the Light* 1891 to pay tribute to her enslaved mother and to exemplify the qualities of mind and spirit that had ensured her own fulfillment in freedom Louis Hughes's *Thirty Years a Slave* 1897 spoke for a generation of black Americans who perceiving the spread of segregation across the South sought to remind the nation of the horrors of its racial history and of the continued dedication of the once enslaved to dignity opportunity and independence

Lindsay Baker and Julie P. Baker have collected all the known WPA Oklahoma slave narratives in this volume for the first time including fourteen never published before Their careful editorial notes detail what is known about the interviewees and the process of preparing the narratives The interviews were made in the late 1930s in Oklahoma Although many African Americans had relocated there after emancipation in 1865 some interviewees had been slaves of Cherokees Chickasaws Choctaws or Creeks in the Indian Territory Their narratives constitute important primary sources on the foodways agricultural practices and home life of Oklahoma Indians This definitive indexed edition will be an important resource for Oklahoma and Southwest historians as well as those interested in the history of African Americans slavery and Oklahoma's Five Tribes For those studying the generation of African American men and women who over a century ago initiated black life in Oklahoma the slave narratives

are a major source of collective memory
