**Productivity Vs Institutions** Abdullah Karasan, 2015 Various empirical studies highlight the importance of productivity and institutions along with the traditional economic growth determinants in the growth process Comparative role of productivity and institutions in convergence however remains ambiguous This paper aims to find out the relative importance of productivity and institutions on conditional convergence across middle income countries by including 36 countries over 1984-2009 period Main reason for selecting this type of countries is their huge convergent potential emerged when they possess adequate level of human and physical capital In this study panel data fixed and random effect techniques are applied and Monte Carlo simulation is run as robustness check Accordingly baseline model including education investment government consumption population growth advancement of knowledge and depreciation as independent variable indicates conditional convergence Moreover productivity represented by Total Factor Productivity and Capital Productivity and institutions proxied by five different variables are included in the model separately and results reveal that total factor productivity accelerates the estimated conditional convergence more than institutions does Bearing in mind the importance of institutions this finding implies that

immediate growth determinants boost economic growth more in the process of development

**China's Productivity Convergence and Growth Potential—A Stocktaking and Sectoral Approach** Min Zhu,Ms.Longmei Zhang,Daoju Peng,2019-11-27 China s growth potential has become a hotly debated topic as the economy has reached an income level susceptible to the middle income trap and financial vulnerabilities are mounting after years of rapid credit expansion However the existing literature has largely focused on macro level aggregates which are ill suited to understanding China s significant structural transformation and its impact on economic growth To fill the gap this paper takes a deep dive into China s convergence progress in 38 industrial sectors and 11 services sectors examines past sectoral transitions and predicts future shifts We find that China s productivity convergence remains

at an early stage with the industrial sector more advanced than services Large variations exist among subsectors with high tech industrial sectors in particular the ICT sector lagging low tech sectors Going forward ample room remains for further convergence but the shrinking distance to the frontier the structural shift from industry to services and demographic changes will put sustained downward pressure on growth which could slow to 5 percent by 2025 and 4 percent by 2030 Digitalization SOE reform and services sector opening up could be three major forces boosting future growth while the risks of a financial crisis and a reversal in global integration in trade and technology could slow the pace of convergence

Nishimura, Takanobu Nakajima, Kozo Kiyota, 2012 Productivity convergence among countries has been investigated extensively with mixed results This paper extends the analysis to the firm level to shed light on the debate of convergence or non convergence We find productivity convergence among firms widely in Japan in both manufacturing industries and non manufacturing ones We obtain these results taking explicit account of exiting firms as a source of selection biases The convergence rate is much faster among firms than countries We also find that there are substantial differences among industries in the convergence speed IT industries that heavily rely on technological progress show faster rates of convergence

**Total Factor Productivity and the Convergence Hypothesis** Stephen M. Miller, Mukti P. Upadhyay, 2002 We study the convergence or lack thereof of total factor productivity and real GDP per worker for a pooled cross section time series sample of developed and developing countries adding breadth and depth to the convergence debate We first estimate total factor productivity from a parsimonious specification of the aggregate production function involving output per worker capital per worker and the labor force both with and without the stock of human capital Then we test for absolute and conditional convergence of total factor productivity and real GDP per worker using cross section and cross section time series data Fixed effect estimates across countries convert the cross section test of absolute convergence into a

pooled test of conditional convergence since it controls for country specific effects Our tests consider both B and O convergence Our findings support both absolute and conditional B convergence of total factor productivity but only conditional convergence of real GDP per worker Further O convergence tests must by definition measure absolute convergence since conditional convergence assumes that an equilibrium dispersion of total factor productivity or real GDP per worker exists We find mixed evidence for absolute O convergence
