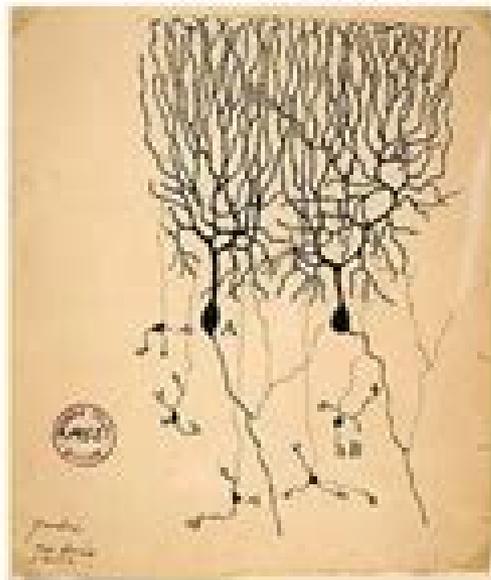



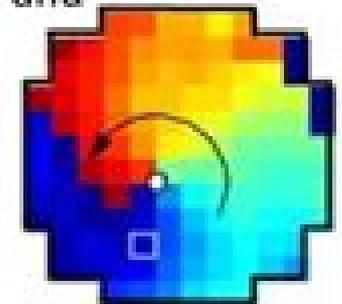
Different approaches are used to study the molecular, cellular, developmental, structural, functional, evolutionary, computational, and medical aspects of the nervous system.



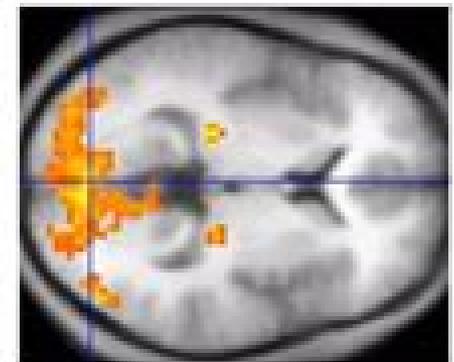
