historical realities Jewish Studies claims to represent but more fundamentally for the intellectual and institutional structures through which it produces these representations He shows how a historicist scholarly narrative quickly consolidated and became hegemonic in part because of its double articulation of a particular American subject and of a transnational historiography that categorically identified that subject as Jewish The ethnological grounding of the Jewish American literary field is no longer tenable Schreier asserts in an argument with broad implications for the reconceptualization of Jewish and other identity based ethnic studies
