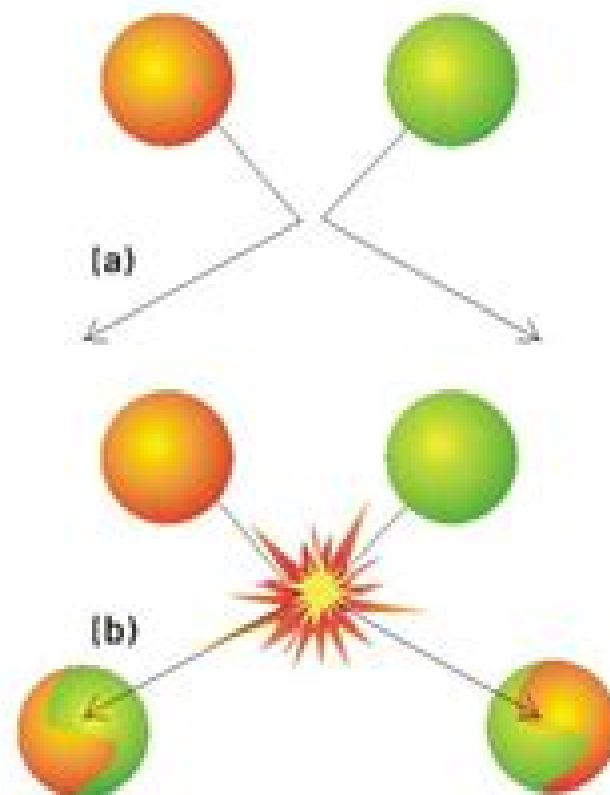


Collision Theory
