INTRODUCTION TO OSTOMY CARE

Living with an ostomy requires individuals to significantly modify their daily routines and accept a "new normal." With skilled education and training, individuals with an ostomy live active and healthy lives.

Most ostomy surgeries are performed due to gastrointestinal disorders such as bowel obstruction, hernia, tumors, cancer, impactions, inflammatory bowel diseases, or traumatic injuries to the bowel. An ostomy is a surgically created opening in the body that allows stool or urine to pass either from the intestine or from the urinary tract as an alternate route for elimination. Elimination of feces or urine is diverted away from the standard elimination process, and a new exit route is created through the abdominal wall to the surface of the skin. With this new exit route, the client lives with a collection bag on the outside of the abdomen. The collection bag requires consistent attention and care.

A client with a new ostomy surgery will require extensive training to manage various aspects of their life, including not only care for the ostomy, but also equipment training, nutritional recommendations, wound and skin management, and necessary interventions for resumption of ADL/IADLs.

ANATOMY OF AN OSTOMY POUCH



- STEPS TO ATTACHING THE OSTOMY BAG**
1. Measure and cut the skin barrier to fit the stoma.
 2. Apply the skin barrier to the stoma.
 3. Attach the ostomy bag to the skin barrier.
 4. Empty the bag when it is 1/3 full.
 5. Clean the stoma and skin barrier.
 6. Change the skin barrier and ostomy bag when needed.



HOW TO REMOVE AN OSTOMY BAG

1. Loosen the adhesive on the skin barrier.

2. Peel the skin barrier away from the stoma.

OSTOMY CARE TIPS

1. Wash your hands before and after handling the ostomy bag.

2. Avoid using harsh soaps or cleansers on the stoma.
