

## Caribbean Studies

Caribbean people continue to migrate outside of the region in search of a better life. Assess the extent to which extra-regional migration is a loss for the Caribbean. (30 marks)

Migration is a historical legacy of the Caribbean. Historically the nature, direction and magnitude of migration in the Caribbean have always been influenced by trends in global and regional socio-economic development. Extra-regional migration is the movement of people from their home countries to other territories outside the Caribbean region. For the last couple of centuries, the Caribbean has shifted from being a net importer of labour to become a net exporter for a plethora of reasons. Some extent of extra-regional migration is a loss for the Caribbean and can be seen in the major gaps in our specialized jobs and labour market due to brain drain, decline in productivity and economic growth, disruption in family structures due to demographic changes, barrel-child syndrome, remittances and foreign mindedness.

Firstly, in search of higher wages and better employment, skilled professionals are on the move worldwide. Caribbean countries like Jamaica, Cuba and Trinidad and Tobago are strong exporters of qualified labourers such as nurses, teachers and farm workers. After the 1960s, the continent of North America (United States and Canada) and, to a lesser extent, Europe has become a preferred destination for migrants from the Caribbean. Although personal gain is attained, the Caribbean is left in ruins as a large percentage of the population of highly educated and skilled persons are leaving the islands contributing to high levels of brain drain. This feature known as brain drain has crippling developmental implications upon a society, as those persons who are indispensable to human and economic development leave for better wages. Jamaica has the second highest brain drain index and has some of the highest rates of migration of its tertiary-educated labour force. Caribbean islands such as Jamaica, have a massive shortage of teachers and institutions such as Campion College lost 19 teachers. As a result educational institutions are without these skilled professionals due to unfavourable working conditions and rising demands in the education sector. Subsequently, the migration of these teachers causes a disruption, weakening the structure of schools as these teachers are oftentimes flexible, adaptable, and in most cases possess the necessary knowledge and skills
