

DICTIONARY OF AFRICAN BIOGRAPHY

Universe Books has made arrangements with the Encyclopaedia Africana Secretariat, Accra, Ghana, to publish a comprehensive dictionary of African biography. The idea of an Encyclopaedia Africana came originally from W.E.B. Du Bois (1868-1963), the eminent civil rights leader, who became a Ghanaian citizen in 1961 and was the first director of the Secretariat. After the death of Dr. Du Bois, an African editorial board that had decided on editorial policy and cooperation among the participating states decided to begin with biographical articles dealing with Africans who had influenced the history and development of their country. To avoid controversy, no living person was to be included. In 1969 the standing committee of the Encyclopaedia obtained affiliation with the Association of African Universities.

By now, several hundred articles have been written by African scholars as well as by prominent historians and area specialists from France, Great Britain, and the United States. Some African states are not yet represented, and the number of articles on Francophone Africa is rather small, largely because some scholars have not honored their promises. The first volume, to be published late in 1972 or early in 1973, will consist of between 200 and 250 biographical entries ranging in time from antiquity to 1970 and representing the following political entities: Angola, Congo, Egypt, Ethiopia, Gabon, Ghana, Guinea, Liberia, the Maghrib (Algeria, Morocco, and Tunisia), Malawi, Mali, Mozambique, Niger, Nigeria, Rhodesia, Senegal, Sierra Leone, South Africa, Sudan, Tanzania, Zambia, and Zanzibar.

Much of the general editing has been completed, and bibliographies have been included in most cases as a guide to further reading; but some of the articles need further checking and some revisions. The publishers would, therefore, welcome the assistance of ASA members and other scholars and subject specialists in this connection.
