Timothy Findley's Novels Between Ethics and Postmodernism

Dagmar Krause, 2005 Timothy Findley 1930-2002 is one of the most important contemporary Canadian writers. His novels have been classified as postmodern, exhibiting characteristic features such as parody, historiographic metafiction, and hybrid genres.
