

olicies designed to promote economic growth. This result reflects limitations in policy analysis methodology as well as an historic tension between relying on economic growth to solve social problems and social welfare's traditional preference for direct government intervention on behalf of the needs of workers and the poor. The extent to which the social policy views of this traditionally liberal think tank correspond to those of the present administration suggest how narrow liberal options have become.

Perhaps this is why the Brookings analysis does not discuss the underlying conservative agenda which uses government tax and spending policies to (1) restructure the welfare state, (2) redistribute income upwards, and (3) weaken the political power of workers, minorities, women, and the poor.² In the name of small government and less red tape, Reaganomics is dismantling the U.S. welfare state. Government dollars are saved not merely by reducing appropriations, but by restructuring many social welfare programs and modifying the postwar relationship between the federal government and the states. These changes will be hard to reverse, since raising taxes is unpopular and large deficits continue to justify budget cuts.

Reagan's tax and spending policies openly favor the rich over the poor on the grounds that wealthy individuals and large corporations are more likely to save and invest, thereby stimulating economic growth. This upward redistribution of income is evident in Reagan's overall assault on the social welfare system, especially the practice of making most severe cuts in means-tested programs serving the poor while sparing somewhat those available to the middle class as well. Likewise, Reagan favors the expansion of tax benefits useful primarily to upper income households and to industry and tax rate cuts which benefit upper bracket taxpayers the most.

The potential exists for political unrest from the victims of Reaganomics and the wider economic crisis. So it is interesting to note that social program cuts also help weaken the political power of workers, women, minorities, and the poor. The cuts reverse gains

these groups have fought for and won since the 1930s and place their trade unions and civil rights and women's groups on the defensive. The ability to fight back is further limited as rising economic insecurity makes it harder for individuals to risk saying no to wage and social benefit cuts. Despite these odds, however, many victims of Reaganomics, including social workers, have organized to fight the assault on their overall standard of living.

Brookings's acceptance of this assault, albeit qualified, reflects a narrowing of liberal options and reduces the gap that once existed between conservative and liberal policies. The convergence of these positions means that the boundaries of social welfare policy are shrinking, leaving social workers to practice in an ever more restricted arena. Only by resisting these trends and fighting back can social work regain its lost terrain.

Americans have never been at ease with their welfare system. Since its inception, there have been determined efforts to find it unconstitutional, to make it unattractive, to dehumanize it. Nevertheless, welfare has persisted. Welfare reform, then, was adopted as the reconciling objective. For more than twenty years, governmental strategies have included work—as an incentive or threat—to arrest the growth of the welfare caseload and control public expenditures. Work, and preparation for it, have been promoted as the means to achieve economic self-sufficiency and personal independence, the means to live well and feel even better. This, despite empirical evidence that full-time employment of the family head does not necessarily guarantee full-family support and that efforts to train welfare recipients to enter the labor force can be of no practical use unless there are available jobs that provide a substantially better living than public assistance.

This book adds to the effort to understand why work strategies have not succeeded in reforming welfare. It focuses on the work and welfare patterns of recipients, and assesses the quality of benefit AFDC families receive from this mix of work and welfare.

The stage for the discussion of the book's main thesis is set well as the author gives her readers a good historical analysis of the derivation of work as a pub-
