One kind of information is called a primary source. A primary source is information that comes directly from the time being studied. For example, if a student wanted to find out about an historical event, a good primary source would be a newspaper or photograph from that time period. Old newspapers and pictures can be found at a library. Another good primary source would be someone who actually observed, or saw, the event. Historians also use secondary sources to study the past. An example of a secondary source would be a history textbook used in schools. These are considered secondary sources because the authors and historians who wrote about the events did not actually experience the event as it happened.
