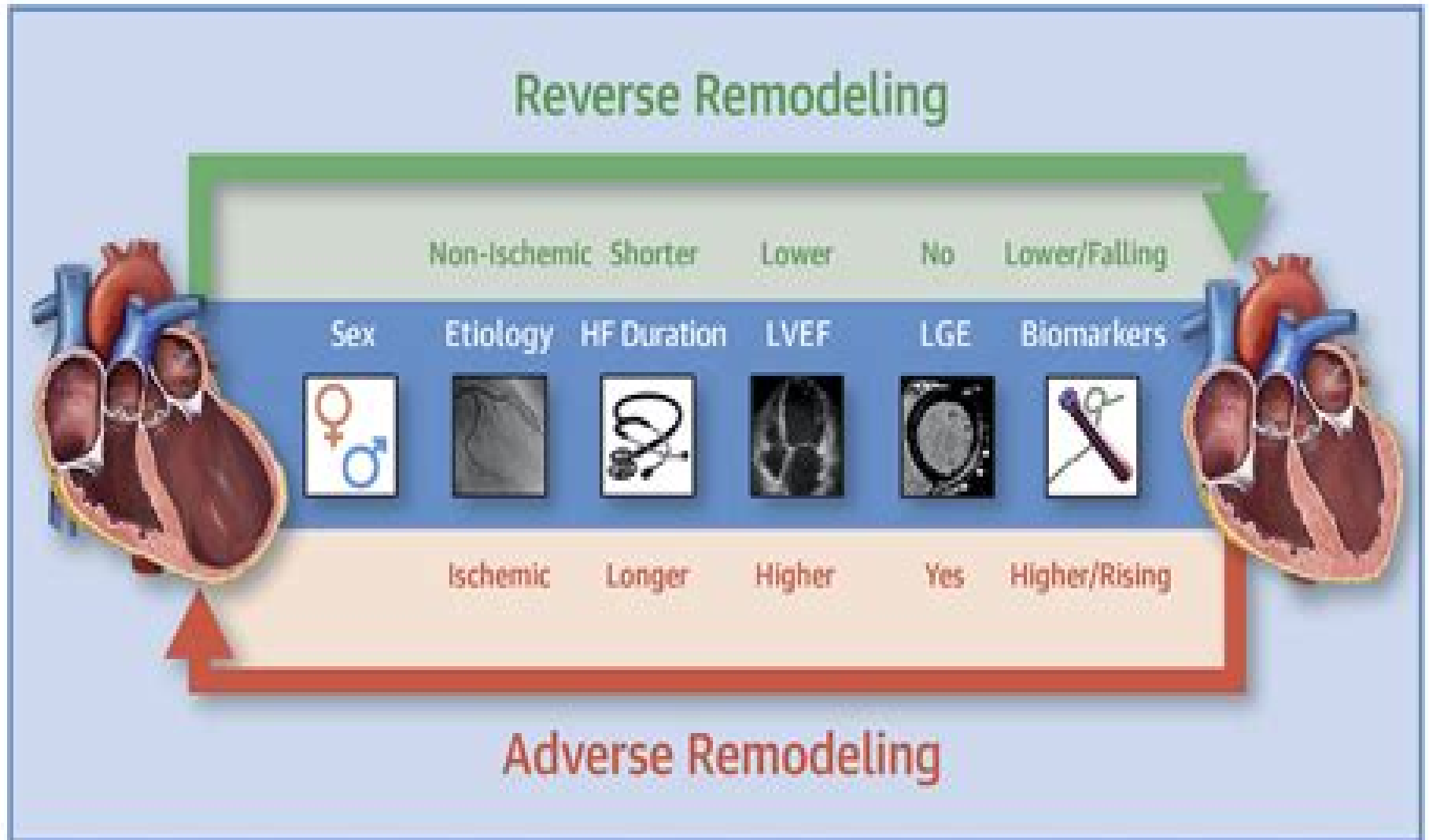

[microform] : Role of the Tissue Inhibitor of Matrix Metalloproteinase-3 Paul William Michael Fedak,2004 TIMPs tissue inhibitors of metalloproteinases are complex endogenous biomolecules that contribute to the regulation of tissue architecture and remodeling in both health and disease Of the four TIMP species TIMP 3 is unique and its role in the adult heart is undefined We hypothesized that TIMP 3 plays a key role in initiating coordinating and maintaining maladaptive cardiac remodeling in the failing heart To establish a proof of concept that TIMP 3 influences myocardial remodeling and dysfunction mutant mice lacking TIMP 3 by gene deletion were assessed for altered cardiac structure and function with aging Cardiomyopathic human and hamster myocardium was similarly assessed for architectural cellular and molecular indices of maladaptive remodeling in relation to TIMP 3 expression The profile of TIMP expression was then assessed in vascular smooth muscle cell transplanted cardiomyopathic hamster hearts to identify a mechanism through which cell transplantation limits the progression of heart failure TIMP 3 gene deletion in mice triggered progressive cardiac dilatation and dysfunction consistent with human dilated cardiomyopathy At the cellular level loss of TIMP 3 expression resulted in profound cardiac matrix disruption and cell death At the molecular level loss of TIMP 3 activated matrix metalloproteinase 9 and the pro inflammatory TNF alpha cytokine system TIMP 3 was reduced in both human and dilated cardiomyopathic hamster myocardium in association with maladaptive cardiac remodeling In hamster cardiomyopathy cell transplantation partially restored deficient TIMP 3 and limited maladaptive matrix remodeling These results suggest that TIMP 3 directly influences matrix homeostasis and cytokine bioactivation in the heart Altered TIMP 3 expression in the failing heart may directly contribute to maladaptive myocardial tissue remodeling cardiac dysfunction and the progression to heart failure Replacement of deficient TIMP 3 by gene or cell therapy may provide a novel approach to prevent disease progression in patients at risk of heart failure

Cardiac Remodeling of Conduction, Repolarization and Excitation-contraction Coupling Qing Lou, 2011 Heart failure is one of the leading causes of death worldwide with rising impact with the increasing ageing population This is in sharp contrast with the limited and non ideal therapies available Approximately 50% of deaths from heart failure are sudden and unexpected and presumably the consequence of lethal ventricular arrhythmias Despite significant reduction of mortality from sudden cardiac death achieved by ICDs and drugs such as beta blockers there remains a large room for improving the survivability of heart failure patients by advancing our understanding of arrhythmogenesis from molecular level to multi cellular tissue level Another important aspect of heart failure is abnormal excitation contraction EC coupling and calcium handling functional changes of which exert great impact on both arrhythmia vulnerability and pump failure Advancing the understanding the remodeling of EC coupling and calcium handling might provide potential molecular and anatomical targets for clinical intervention In this dissertation I first developed two optical imaging systems both hardware and software for quantifying the conduction repolarization and excitation contraction coupling The first one is the panoramic imaging system for mapping the entire ventricular epicardium of a rabbit heart The second one is the dual imaging system for simultaneous measurement of action potential and calcium transient Using the systems I developed I conducted two rabbit studies to investigate the role electrical instability and structural heterogeneity in the induction and maintenance of arrhythmias We first identified the importance of both dynamic instability and effective tissue size in the spontaneous termination of arrhythmia in the normal rabbit heart We then identified novel mechanism of how healed myocardial infarction promotes the induction of ventricular arrhythmia Finally guided by the knowledge from the animal studies I studied the failing human heart with the aim to advance our understanding of cardiac electrophysiology in human heart failure We first demonstrated the transmural heterogeneity of EC coupling in nonfailing heart and identified potential mechanisms of electrical and mechanical dysfunction by quantifying the remodeling of EC coupling We then studied the remodeling of conduction and

repolarization with the aim to determine of the role of dispersion of repolarization and electrical instability in the induction of arrhythmia in human heart failure

endothelial injury vascular smooth muscle cell proliferation and matrix deposition This results in atherosclerosis and or stenosis followed by myocardial infarction stroke etc Thus studies on the mechanism of cardiovascular remodeling and new therapeutic approaches are important scientifically and clinically Cardiovascular remodeling is a response of specific cardiovascular cells including cardiomyocytes endothelial smooth muscle cells and interstitial cells to noxious hemodynamic metabolic and inflammatory stimuli The remodeling may initially be functional compensatory and adaptive but it progresses to structural alterations that become pathogenic when the damaging stimuli are sustained The mechanism of cardiovascular remodeling is complex and recent studies focus on improving and or reversing the remodeling by clarifying molecular mechanisms and identifying novel therapies Pharmacological anti remodeling RNA based long non coding RNA and microRNA treatment cell based iPS cardiac repair and cell free exosome approaches have been shown to improve cardiovascular remodeling alongside proangiogenic pro survival proliferative and immunogenic factors stimulating endogenous proliferative potential of cardiomyocytes However though advanced studies have progressed the prognosis of the affected patients remains poor Therefore understanding novel mechanisms identifying remodeling biomarkers and developing new therapeutic drugs and approaches can lead to new therapeutic options for treating patients with cardiovascular diseases
