**Factors mediating performance monitoring in humans - from context to personality** Patrizia Thoma, Christian Bellebaum, In our everyday life we constantly monitor our behaviour and adapt our responses following performance errors and feedback information from our environment Receiving positive or negative feedback which can be social monetary or some other type of feedback classifiable as good or bad can encourage us to continue with a specific action or may lead us to discontinue the same behaviour respectively Additionally we daily observe errors being committed by other people or other people receiving feedback for their behaviour We are able to infer how they feel in response to errors or feedback and whether we feel sorry for their failures and happy about their successes may depend on our empathic concern and on the relationship to the observed person At the same time we can also learn from other people s errors by adaptively modifying our own behaviour Recently a growing number of researchers in the neuroscientific community has begun to establish links between the ability to empathize with others and error feedback processing The ACC seems to be strongly involved in both error feedback processing and in affective empathic responding and positive relationships between error and feedback related ACC activity and self rated dispositional empathy have been reported Various contextual factors like the relationship between the observer and the observed person or person related characteristics like age gender and psychopathological symptoms may potentially modify this relationship In spite of these theoretical advances there are still crucial gaps in our knowledge of the different contextual factors and personality characteristics that affect performance monitoring in humans For instance it is not well understood how different empathy components might relate to different stages and different forms of error feedback processing Also the ability to engage in empathic perspective taking might be more related to observational than to active learning and empathy should become more relevant when the behaviour observed in someone else is also relevant for one s own actions One promising account in studying the relationship between person characteristics performance context and action monitoring is the investigation of these concepts across the lifespan While performance monitoring might be increasingly compromised in older individuals due to structural and functional changes in the relevant brain areas it might be partly compensated for by a heightened tendency and experience to engage in affective perspective taking Furthermore studying clinical populations may help us to disentangle the complex interdependence between performance monitoring and psychopathological symptoms Overall for the current Research Topic issue we would like to solicit original research articles reviews as well as opinion and method papers which investigate the neurocognitive mechanisms supporting performance monitoring providing a link to contextual factors or personality traits Studies using a range of different methods behavioural imaging electrophysiological etc investigating healthy populations with or without a lifespan perspective or clinical populations are welcome and authors with different academic backgrounds and working in different disciplines are

encouraged to participate in order to promote a lively and integrative debate

Cognitive and Physiological Aspects of Attention to Personally Relevant Negative Information in Depression Greg Jeremy Siegle, 1999 Evidence suggests depressed individuals pay excessive attention to negative information The current research investigates the nature and clinical implications of such attention biases A computational neural network reflecting interacting brain systems that identify emotional and nonemotional aspects of information is described in which depression is identified with strongly learning certain negative information The model's behavior suggested that depressed people are reminded of and attend to personally relevant negative information in response to many stimuli Predictions for depressed and nondepressed individuals reaction times signal detection rates and the time course of cognitive load in response to emotional stimuli were derived from the computational model To evaluate these predictions pupil dilations and reaction times were collected from 24 unmedicated depressed and 25 nondepressed adults in response to emotional lexical decision and valence identification tasks Pupil dilation was used to index cognitive load Mixed ANOVA planned contrasts were employed to evaluate predictions In support of model derived predictions depressed individuals rated many stimuli as negative more than nondepressed individuals The network's behavior suggested that depressed individuals would be quicker to say that negative words were negative than positive words were positive and that this difference would be reduced in nondepressed individuals This prediction was supported empirically Principal components analysis of pupil dilations revealed early attentional components at or before reaction times and late possibly ruminative components peaking 2 and 4 seconds after reaction times The computational model suggested cognitive load indexed by pupil dilation would be highest for nondepressed individuals during early stages of attention but highest for depressed individuals during later stages of attention This prediction was supported Contrary to predictions differences in depressed individuals dilations to positive and negative stimuli were not detected These data suggest depressed individuals may not initially attend to the content of presented information but may quickly associate any incoming information with whatever made them depressed Sustained attention to personally relevant negative information may characterize depressive attention biases Targeting implicated cognitive and brain processes may improve interventions for depression

Dombeck,1995 Many cognitive theories of negative affect etiology suggest that a lack of integration among the cognitive structures comprising the self may increase individuals vulnerability to disorders of negative affect This dissertation is concerned with the construction of a measure of self integration a quantification of the degree to which cognitive structures underlying the self are integrated It is hypothesized that individuals possessing poorly integrated self structure may be at increased risk for developing disorders of negative affect Over the course of three studies the new instrument was refined from an initially large item pool into a 30 item questionnaire through the use of factor analytic techniques The resulting Threats to Identity Questionnaire TIQ contains three factors which have been labeled Fear of Emotion Identity Fragmentation and Lack of Confidence in Coping Elevations of these factors are thought to reflect poorly integrated self structure The TIQ shows good internal reliability and a possesses a stable factor structure The TIQ scales also show good convergent and divergent validity with other theoretically relevant psychological instruments Although the TIQ scales correlate positively with indices of negative affectivity in theoretically predicted directions a fourth study demonstrated that the TIQ could explain variation on personality and information processing measures that cannot be accounted for based on negative affectivity alone Specifically poorly integrated anxious subjects report significantly less PANAS positive affectivity rate themselves as less calm and rational and more anxious and needy and produce larger discrepancies between their actual and idealized selves than highly integrated anxious subjects Highly integrated subjects also respond faster than poorly integrated subjects on a Stroop task Despite these differences these groups are not statistically distinguishable on indices of anxiety symptoms and negative affectivity These data support both the potential importance of the self integration conception as a factor in negative affect etiology and the usefulness of the TIQ as a valid and reliable measure of self integration in a college population The use of the TIQ in future studies examining personality and psychopathology may allow discrimination of important relationships currently masked by negative affectivity
