Coleridge, Thomas Hutchinson, 2017-05-19 *Lyrical Ballads with a Few Other Poems* is a collection of poems by William Wordsworth and Samuel Taylor Coleridge first published in 1798 and generally considered to have marked the beginning of the English Romantic movement in literature The immediate effect on critics was modest but it became and remains a landmark changing the course of English literature and poetry Most of the poems in the 1798 edition were written by Wordsworth with Coleridge contributing only four poems to the collection including one of his most famous works *The Rime of the Ancient Mariner* A second edition was published in 1800 in which Wordsworth included additional poems and a preface detailing the pair's avowed poetical principles For another edition published in 1802 Wordsworth added an appendix titled *Poetic Diction* in which he expanded the ideas set forth in the preface Wordsworth and Coleridge set out to overturn what they considered the priggish learned and highly sculpted forms of 18th century English poetry and bring poetry within the reach of the average person by writing the verses using normal everyday language They place an emphasis on the vitality of the living voice that the poor use to express their reality Using this language also helps assert the universality of human emotions Even the title of the collection recalls rustic forms of art the word *lyrical* links the poems with the ancient rustic bards and lends an air of spontaneity while ballads are an oral mode of storytelling used by the common people In the Advertisement included in the 1798 edition Wordsworth explained his poetical concept The majority of the following poems are to be considered as experiments They were written chiefly with a view to ascertain how far the language of conversation in the middle and lower classes of society is adapted to the purpose of poetic pleasure 4 If the experiment with vernacular language was not enough of a departure from the norm the focus on simple uneducated country people as the subject of poetry was a signal shift to modern literature One of the main themes of *Lyrical Ballads* is the return to the original state of nature in which people led a purer and more innocent existence Wordsworth subscribed to Rousseau's belief that humanity was essentially good but was corrupted by the influence of society This may be linked with the sentiments spreading through Europe just prior to the French Revolution

Samuel Taylor Coleridge 21 October 1772 25 July 1834 was an English poet literary critic philosopher and theologian who with his friend William Wordsworth was a founder of the Romantic Movement in England and a member of

the most superficial level that each poet seemed to be the other's ideal audience. Below that surface she insists there were radical dissimilarities between the two which led to a kind of creative misunderstanding by which each artist clearly defined himself in relation to the other. Because it is in the poet's private language of allusion that these differences are most clearly seen, the book concludes that this private language spoken by artists amongst themselves may in fact be the most aggressive of literary forms.

Lyrical Ballads, with a Few Other Poems William Wordsworth, Samuel Taylor Coleridge, 2007-11. William Wordsworth (1770-1850) was a major English romantic poet who with Samuel Taylor Coleridge helped launch the Romantic Age in English literature with their 1798 joint publication *Lyrical Ballads*. Wordsworth's masterpiece is generally considered to be *The Prelude*, an autobiographical poem of his early years that was revised and expanded a number of times. It was never published during his lifetime and was only given the title after his death. Up until this time it was generally known as the poem to Coleridge. Wordsworth was England's Poet Laureate from 1843 until his death in 1850. Samuel Taylor Coleridge (1772-1834) was an English poet, critic, and philosopher, one of the Lake Poets. He is probably best known for his poems *The Rime of the Ancient Mariner* and *Kubla Khan*, as well as his major prose work *Biographia Literaria*. Coleridge was critical of the literary taste of his contemporaries and a literary conservative insofar as he was afraid that the lack of taste in the ever-growing masses of literate people would mean a continued desecration of literature itself.

Coleridge's Political Poetics Jacob Lloyd, 2023-12-18. This book considers Samuel Taylor Coleridge's engagement with Whig poetry, a tradition of verse from the eighteenth century which celebrated the political and constitutional arrangements of Britain as guaranteeing liberty. It argues that during the 1790s Coleridge was able to articulate radical ideas under the cover of widely accepted principles through his references to this poetry. He positioned his poetry within a mainstream discourse even as he favoured radical social change. Jacob Lloyd argues that the poets Mark Akenside, William Lisle Bowles, and William Cowper each provided Coleridge with a kind of Whig poetics to which he responded. When these references are understood, much of Coleridge's work which seems purely personal or imaginative gains a political dimension. In addition, Lloyd reassesses Coleridge's relationship with Thomas Percy's *Reliques of Ancient English Poetry* to provide an original political reading of *The Rime of the Ancient Mariner*. This book revises our understanding of the political and poetic development of a major poet and in doing so provides a new model for the origins of British Romanticism more broadly.
