Particular attention is paid to Rus although subjugated by the Mongols Rus churchmen monks and leading princes all drew on Byzantine religious texts and imagery. From the later fifteenth century Moscow's rulers began to be portrayed as new guardians of religious correctness even as the World's End supposedly drew nigh.
