1. **Cournot Model (Quantity Competition)** : Firms set output simultaneously, considering rivals' expected quantities in a competitive market.
2. **Bertrand Model (Price Competition)** : Firms compete by setting prices simultaneously, assuming rivals' prices are fixed.
3. **Stackelberg Model (Leadership in Quantity)** : One firm (the leader) sets its output first, and the other firms (followers) react accordingly.
