Andrey Bely University of Kentucky, 1978 Andrey Bely novelist essayist theoretician critic and poet was a central figure in the Russian Symbolist movement of the 1920s the most important literary movement in Russia in this century Bely articulated a Symbolist aesthetic and originated a new approach to the study of Russian metrics and versification giving rise to a new scholarly discipline that still thrives in the West Although regarded by some critics including Vladimir Nabokov as the author of the greatest Russian novel of this century Bely has been nearly forgotten in his native country for ideological reasons In the [Andrey Bely A.
