

In particular, there have been only very limited attempts to write about the philosophical, conceptual, and controversial issues in this field to pull together diverse findings and to provide some general perspective on its future. As will probably be apparent, I am a clinical psychiatrist who also has a fundamental interest in animal behavior, especially primate social behavior. I entered the field from a clinical research standpoint to develop some animal models of depression after being stimulated to do so by Dr. William Bunney, then at the National Institute of Mental Health and now at the University of California, Irvine.
