

- **Ecological genetics** is a multidisciplinary endeavour with the aim to understand phenotypic adaptation in response to specific selective agents in a particular ecological setting and in terms of the underlying genetic changes
- Ecological genetics is the study of genetics in natural field populations. It is the study of how ecologically relevant traits evolve in natural populations
- Ecological genetics is a hybrid field used to describe ecological influences on genetic properties within and between populations
- Ecological genetics focuses more specifically on the genetics of ecologically important traits, i.e., traits that influence ecological relationships
- Such traits are involved in interactions between and within species, and between an organism and its environment, particularly those that determine fitness.
- Ecological genetics overlaps substantially with molecular ecology, a closely related field that uses molecular genetic tools to study questions in ecology
