Slatkes had begun conducting research on ter Brugghen's paintings in the 1960s with the expectation of eventually publishing a new monograph on the artist. Wayne Franits, a former student of Slatkes's, is currently Professor of Fine Arts at Syracuse University, Syracuse, NY. He has authored numerous publications on seventeenth century Dutch and Flemish art.
