




Small, slender, conical shell with many whorls. (Species name not visible)



Large, moderately thick shell with rounded whorls and deeply impressed cords on all whorls. (Species name not visible)

**Turritella nitida** Hutton  
This shell, extremely found in relation to height. Almost straight-sided with rather wide impressed suture. Fine spiral lines on each whorl. Yellowish white with anal brown streak and thin spiral pink line. (Species name not visible)

**Family ARCHITECTONICA**  
Small to large shells, usually very whorled. Medium to very large, with deep umbilicus which is open up to apex and reveals structure of inner side of each whorl. Radially and axially ribbed, ribbing on inside edge of whorls usually corrugated. Some species show very close resemblance to each other and the differences between them are often difficult to see, particularly in juveniles. Operculum usually continuous but in a few species it is calcareous. About six genera in warm and tropical seas.

**Genus ARCHITECTONICA** Hutton  
Indisane Linnæus  
Medium sized to large shells with open, tightly coiled whorls, sharp peripheral keel and large, wide umbilicus open to apex. Inner surface of whorls corrugated. Few species in warm and tropical seas.


