of worth and it cannot be denied that Cynicism survived when much of immeasurably greater intellectual value perished To the student of ancient philosophy there is in Cynicism scarcely more than a rudimentary and debased version of the ethics of Socrates which exaggerates his austerity to a fanatic asceticism hardens his irony to sardonic laughter at the follies of man kind and affords no parallel to his genuine love of knowledge Well might Plato have said of the first and greatest Cynic That man is Socrates gone mad But to the student of social history and of ancient thought as distinct from philosophy there is much of interest in Cynicism *Diogenes The Cynic* Luis E.
