Social roles are sets of social behaviors assigned to people based upon social status.

EXAMPLE 1

Status: Leader

Roles: Organize, set rules, exercise authority

Every organized community has leaders. A leader occupies an important social role. Leaders are necessary to help ensure there is a clear social hierarchy and chain of decision-making.

EXAMPLE 2

Status: Follower

Roles: Listen, observe, follow, learn

If there are social leaders, there also need to be social followers. Every leader needs a group of followers who will provide them with social authority. They consent to the leader's authority, follow their lead, and even do tasks assigned to them by the leader.
