republicanism in Israel and populism in Northern Ireland The collapse of ethnic democracy in Northern Ireland resulted from the weakening of populism that depended on British monetary subsidies for its implementation whilst the erosion of ethnic democracy in Israel resulted from the decline of civic republicanism since the onset of economic liberalization in 1985
