Houlihan provides a systematic and unparalleled survey of all the bird life depicted by the ancient Egyptians in art and hieroglyphic writing some 72 species plus bats with a list of known mummified species and discussions on their religious and secular associations and many illustrations. Their present day distributions are compared with that known from the time of the Pharaohs. A checklist of the birds of modern Egypt is provided by Steven Goodman.
