

Shadow Killer Stalks Boston

Who Took Lives Of 8 Women?

BOSTON (AP) — Who strangled Anna Grewer? Nina Nicholas? Helen Blake? Margaret Davis? Ma Irga? Jane Sullivan? Sophie Clark? Patricia Bassette?

These eight questions, left unanswered in 1961, haunted homicide detectives in Greater Boston as the new year arrived.

Not since the terror and outrage days of 76 years ago, when Jack the Ripper murdered women in the murky gaslit streets of London, has a more subtle dread touched women of a big city.

Sites of the eight Boston killings — starting last June — have ranged all the way from the heart of old Boston to scattered residential areas and a nearby city. Strangely, in no instance did the killer, or killers, leave any evidence of forced entry into the murder apartments.

A rising business in new locks and door chains has testified to the pervasiveness of the fear among women throughout the area.

HOW MANY

It starts on July 1 and Hyde Park home on the streets in

North End hotel. Weapon: Bare hands.

AUG. 18 — Mrs. Ma Irga, 75, a widow living alone in an apartment on Beacon Hill in downtown Boston. Weapon: A pillow case.

AUG. 18 — Perhaps — but not discovered until Aug. 18 — Miss Jane Sullivan, 47, a practical nurse living alone in a first-floor Dorchester apartment. Body partly decomposed in bathtub. Death from strangulation. Weapon undetermined.

DEC. 1 — Miss Sophie Clark, 31, student in a Beacon Hill school, who returned to her

man in his mid-30s with long-curled hair, vanished. A Negro woman tenant described him vividly, even to his strange gray eyes, fairly tall, fairly slender.

He arrived at her apartment, explaining he had been hired to do some painting. But the housewife became alarmed when he talked strangely.

"I was alone, but I told him not to talk so loud because he would wake up my husband in the next room."

"You mean you are not alone," he said — started. Then

remembering that he had the wrong apartment, he left hurriedly.

But the trail faded. The killer was lost in a city wilderness.

POPULAR

The steel pipes, a valuable source of police information in more conventional crime, was lacking. The stranger obviously went unrecognized as a killer, or potential killer, among his acquaintances.

The latest of the stranglings was different. Patricia Bassette, who had been one of the most popular girls in high school in Middlebury, Vt., had gone to college for a while, worked for

an airline in New York, and then had come to Boston where she made numerous friends.

Detectives, using differences in her slaying, hinted that the man who killed her might have deliberately copied the earlier stranglings.

A medical examiner said she was one month pregnant and found evidence she had entertained a man before she was killed — late Saturday night or Sunday morning.

A 29-year-old married man, also from Vermont, admitted visiting her several times, but

he insisted he had not seen her since Dec. 18. He offered to take a lie detector test.

KNOWN VICTIM

Investigators hinted that in this case, at least, they were looking for someone who knew the victim well, who might have quarreled with her, possibly over circumstances arising from her pregnant condition.

Her killer, they said, might have planned her death with overtones to suggest that she died at the hands of the phantom strangler — the phantom strangler who still eludes detection.
