Theories of Deviance: Sociological Perspectives

Structural Functionalism

Views deviance as a necessary part of society, contributing to social order and stability by defining boundaries.

Social Conflict Theory

Argues that deviance is a result of power imbalances and inequalities within society.

Symbolic Interactionism

Labeling Theory
