Samuel Pepys grew up and lived in the capital between the years 1656 and 1696, a period of forty years. And it's from these journals, spread over a quarter of a century, with some of the extracts now being a startling half a century old, he's gone on to write a book, *A Capital Diary*.

Edinburgh 1971 1996 The format of the book features a single extract selected from one day in the year thus 365 posts or blogs plus of course one to represent a single leap year too making for 366 extracts some of which are short more that are of medium length and when the day merited it or the muse and the desire took hold and the pen flowed a few of which are of essay length Making the choice of which year should appear was difficult and Samuel had to discipline himself to selecting but a single extract so many excellent alternatives unfortunately hit the editing floor many of which would have been superior to other parts of the book Samuel s journal tells the story of the day to day life of what it was like to live in Scotland s capital during the decades of the 1970s 1980s and 1990s until the author leaves the city in 1996 to begin a new family life in the Highlands The book is based on extracts from his diaries and makes no pretension to being of any great literary value or merit The diaries were never intended for publication only as a personal keepsake recording the days and the weeks and the years and then the decades after all who might ever be interested in the day to day life of an ordinary Edinburgher However with the passage of time Samuel believes they offer a certain period charm capturing day to day life in the capital and the social and cultural life of one ordinary Edinburgh family during the late twentieth century And perhaps their only true literary merit is that they may be a unique such record of what it was like to live in the city during that era Everything changes but the cyclical rhythms of the seasons are a constant and of course much of the city remains the same and is instantly recognisable today Indeed until Samuel began the project he had no conception of how much that British cultural aspect the weather features quite so often or so regularly Unlike say a recent prominent gossipy political diary because Samuel was never writing for an audience there s no real intention or structure to them he simply writes as he pleases and as he feels and expresses himself so occasionally being somewhat harsh in his judgement on others but at heart he loves his friends and his family Overall very very little editing was undertaken but the first two Letts Schoolboys Diaries which only leave the space for small note like entries have been expanded in later years he used A4 notebooks which allowed him to write as little or as much as he felt like as well as allowing him to include photographs tickets letters etc within the leaves of the notebooks The journals begin in 1971 when the author is a 14 year old Boroughmuir schoolboy and continue through to him approaching middle age when he celebrates his 40th birthday in 1996 and leaves the capital The posts take the form of a Dali folded clock so that although the diary extracts correlate with the day of the year the History of Scotland to the Present Time: From the accession of Mary Stewart to the Revolution of 1689 Peter Hume Brown,1911 **Edinburgh in the Nineteenth Century, Being a Diary of the Chief Events ...
