Walther, Paul Gauguin, 2000 A Frenchman in Tahiti After starting a career as a bank broker Paul Gauguin born 1848 turned to painting only at age twenty five After initial successes within the Impressionist circle he broke with Vincent van Gogh and subsequently when private difficulties caused him to become restless embarked on a peripatetic life wandering first through Europe and finally in the search for pristine originality and unadulterated nature to Tahiti The paintings created from this time to his death in 1903 brought him posthumous fame In pictures devoid of any attempt at romantically disguising the life style of the primitive island peoples Gauguin was able to convey the magical effect that both the landscapes and life of the natives their body language charm and beauty had on him Wearying of his reputation as a South Sea painter Gauguin finally determined to return to France but died of syphilis on the Marquis Islands before his departure About the Series Each book in TASCHEN's Basic Art series features a detailed chronological summary of the life and oeuvre of the artist covering his or her cultural and historical importance a concise biography approximately 100 illustrations with explanatory captions

before their time He began his painting career in Europe during the later part of the 19th century at a time when huge industrial technological change was taking place While some artists revelled in these new developments Gauguin was less impressed with these technological advances and veered away from what he saw as a modern world however at the same time he was embarking on new innovations of his own Gauguin used an Impressionist style for a time with patches of color applied through large brushstrokes but he resisted the changing modernized world and chose instead a simpler less cluttered approach As cities like Paris grew and developed Gauguin chose to base himself in the French countryside where a more rural way of life suited his palette and the life he wished to capture through his oils Later this search for a more primitive existence would lead him to the South Pacific and Tahiti before finally finding himself in the Marquesas Islands in French Polynesia His association collaboration and friendship with Vincent Van Gogh is probably one of the most important periods of Gauguin s life It may have been just nine weeks at the Studio of the South Van Gogh s vision for a group of likeminded artists and there may have only been two of them but the time these artists spent together before they violently quarreled was to prove invaluable in the history and development of art

WORKBOOK WITH CD ENCLOSED FULL COLOR MUSIC AND ART EDUCATION Gauguin felt that his approach to color the pinks beside purple or yellows near orange had nothing to do with Naturalism or Impressionism but everything to do with music He thought like a composer and he knew it When critics complained that Gauguin s paintings lacked perspective seemed flat and that his colors were unnatural the artist turned to music to defend himself The journalist Eug ne Tardieu asked Gauguin why he painted red dogs and pink skies and Gauguin replied I do it purposefully Its like music I take an idea from life and arrange lines and colors to get symphonies and harmonies I do not paint mere representations of reality My paintings should make you think the way music does simply through the mysterious affinities the connections that exist between our minds and arrangements of colors and lines Gauguin felt that if people would only allow artists the same freedom from realism that musicians naturally enjoy they would understand his work He wrote in his journal Musicians live in a special world of sounds and harmonies Painting should be special too The sister art to music painting lives on forms and colors Color like music is vibration Together the music and book of Red Dogs and Pink Skies celebrate not only Gauguin s paintings and ideas about art and music but also the relationship of painting to music generally The design of the book from the decorative borders and backgrounds to the humorous images are based on details and elements of Gauguin s own work The music was inspired by listening to the paintings For Gauguin himself said Color is the language of the listening eye
