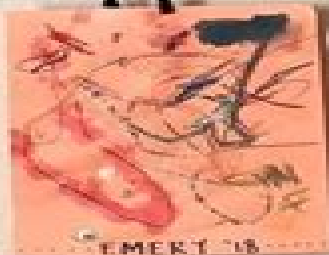

this is educated out of them Art is an area where all children can perform and learn to develop not just their artistic creative talents but also their ability to think critically and with imagination Students output was partially dictated by their intrinsic cultural traits while at the same time could be shaped and influenced by the extrinsic social and physical environment in which the art curriculum itself play a crucial role
