**Jizi and His Art in Contemporary China** David Adam Brubaker, Chunchen Wang, 2015-02-12 This interdisciplinary study promotes the thesis that some contemporary Chinese ink artists succeed in using principles of traditional Chinese aesthetics to convey the union of self with nature, others, and the universe. The investigation is a case study of the writings and paintings of Jizi, an ink wash artist in Beijing who combines images of icy mountains, Tibetan landscapes, cosmic vistas, and enclosures of personal existence.
