- He belonged to the Moravian religious sect.
- He left school at 10.
- He grew up in a Liberal household dissenting tradition – meaning he rejected the church of England.

### Visions

- Blake experience ‘eidetic imagery’ they are real sensory perceptions, not imagination the tendency to have them is high in young children not adult such as Blake.
- Blake saw visions from an early age at 4 he saw Gods head at the window and started screaming – his mother beat him for saying he saw the prophet, Ezekiel.
- Later on, he also saw visions of angels in trees and angels walking.
- Blake believed these visions were a ‘true perception of reality’ seeing the past ‘fallen world’.

### Work

- He worked in Westminster Abby engraving the tombs, he was influenced by its gothic style and faded brightness.
- He had some painting showcased in the Royal academy.
- In his later life he was known as an engraver
- He died almost penniless therefore some debate whether he should be bracketed with upper class ‘romantic poets.’

### Marriage

- Married Catherine Boucher 1782 – she was 5 years younger than him
- He trained his wife to be an engraver
- They were unable to have children
