To pass laws which suppressed and neglected the coloured people, the politico-philosophical ideology of the South African Apartheid system was enforced with brutality. Deegan 2001: 23-25. This political attitude led to pure spite and violent attacks among racial groupings. The apartheid and especially the violence between races was at its height during 1960 when 67 demonstrators were killed by the police at the Sharpeville Massacre and 1976 when the Revolt in Soweto took place. In April 1994 the first democratic elections were held in South Africa and it ended in ushered in a new era of reconciliation and restitution. Boaduo 2012: 954.
