For Roman Catholics, Tabernacle typology proves no one eats the sacrifice where blood enters the Tabernacle. Jews hold to the eternality of God's Word, but they cannot hold to the shadows and miss the reality. Ezekiel's ritual changes Mosaic Law. It also forces them to find God's suffering servant during the existence of the second temple.
