navigate the intricate relationships between the various Frankish factions He expanded the Carolingian family's land holdings through strategic alliances and conquest ensuring the family's dominance His military reforms including the establishment of a permanent cavalry also contributed to his ability to maintain control and expand his territories By the time of his death in 741 Charles Martel had secured a powerful legacy both as a ruler and a protector of Christianity in the West

specialized mounted soldiers and the execution of lengthy sieges employing artillery In order to sustain their long term strategy the early Carolingians relied on a late Roman model whereby soldiers were recruited from among the militarized population who were required by law to serve outside their immediate communities The ability to mass and train large armies from among farmers and urban dwellers gave the Carolingians the necessary power to lay siege to the old Roman fortress cities that dominated the military topography of the West Bachrach includes fresh accounts of Charles Martel's defeat of the Muslims at Poitiers in 732 and Pippin's successful siege of Bourges in 762 demonstrating that in the matter of warfare there never was a western European Dark Age that ultimately was enlightened by some later Renaissance The early Carolingians built upon surviving military institutions adopted late antique technology and effectively utilized their classical intellectual inheritance to prepare the way militarily for Charlemagne's empire
