Kwajalein Missile Range while granting the Marshallese greater political autonomy additional financial assistance and a mechanism to settle nuclear claims Martha Smith Norris argues that despite COFA s implementation in 1986 and Washington s pivot toward the Asia Pacific region in the post Cold War era the United States has yet to provide adequate compensation to the Republic of the Marshall Islands for the extensive health and environmental damages caused by the US testing programs
